

:: Gallery at the Commons Vision [Pilot Program]

Aligned with the Learning Commons in the Kennedy Library, Gallery at the Commons is an opportunity for a campus crossroads, which will provide exhibition space for interdisciplinary exchanges where technology, scholarly and artistic expression, and diverse perspectives collaborate in a shared dynamic hub.

Criteria for the use of the Gallery:

1. Projects are identified by Learning Commons Partners and will have been completed during the quarter prior to the exhibition date.
2. Projects provide a tangible example of the role that the Learning Commons' resources played in student and faculty inquiry and discourse, which in turn serves as a showcase for the successful use of these resources.
3. Eligible projects make use of all three services provided by the Learning Commons partners:
 - Robert E. Kennedy Library (LIB) delivers information resources.
 - Center for Teaching and Learning (CTL) offers pedagogical consultation.
 - Information Technology Services (ITS) provides enabling technology.
4. College Librarians provide project management for the student exhibition project, ensuring coordination with academic faculty and library colleagues. They see the project through from conception to strike.

Guidelines

1. Exhibitions run for five weeks per quarter.
2. The Learning Commons will exhibit one project per quarter; exceptions determined by space and staff availability.
3. To qualify, projects must consist of tangible materials to exhibit (as opposed to digital pieces).
4. Digital projects can be accommodated on a case-by-case basis, but are limited to one projector per exhibit.
5. The University and the Learning Commons Partners do not take responsibility for the security of material on exhibit.
6. In addition to the above criteria and guidelines, the Gallery at the Commons adheres to the Robert E. Kennedy Library's Exhibit Policy and Guidelines. Copies of the policy can be obtained by contacting Library Administration at 756-2345.
