- A. A clear articulation of how you define Learn by Doing;
- **B.** A compelling case based on this definition for how your scholarship will inform the value of Learn by Doing approaches to pedagogy;
- **C.** A description of the project that includes the methodology, objectives, theoretical justification, and significance of the project;
- **D.** A statement of progress to date and a timeline of activities to project completion;
- **E.** A description of how the findings will be used and disseminated;
- **F.** A statement of intellectual merit and expected impact of this research.

A current curriculum vitae for the applicant. In the case of a collaborative project, please provide CVs for all team members.

Additional materials (optional). An unpublished manuscript, grant proposal, letter of support from a colleague or student familiar with the in-progress scholarship, or other materials representative of the scholarship may be submitted.
